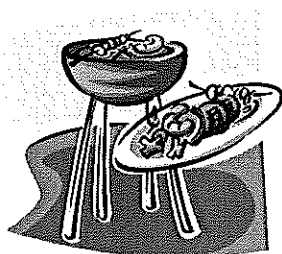
Lakeside Brat Fry

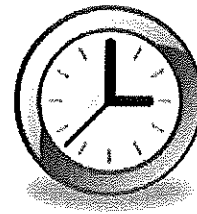
Summer Volunteer Opportunities

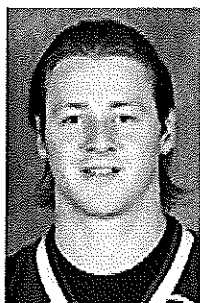
Joe Piskula Summer Camp

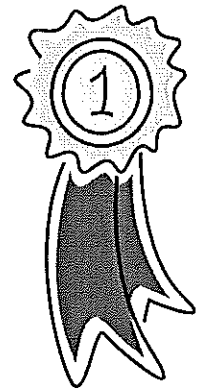
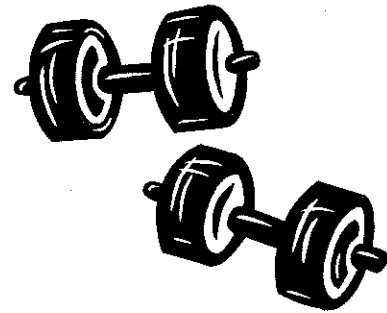

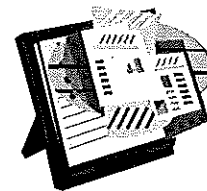
Newsletter

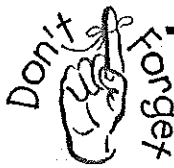

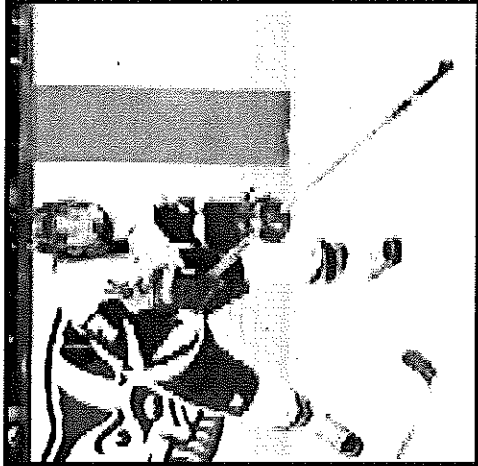

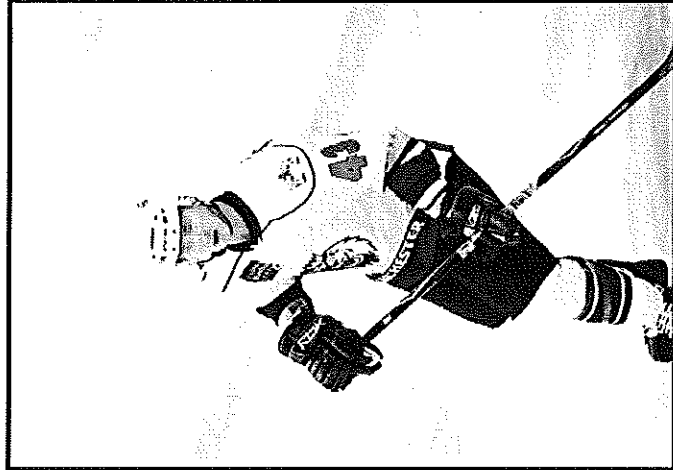
