Must be currently certified as a coach with USA Hockey and be committed and actively participating in current year. Parent coaches are still responsible for sibling skater's hours. Bring proof of certification upon sign up.

*Standard Hours consist of 25 winter hours per skater (maximum 75 hours per family) and 15 summer hours per family. Failure to complete any winter/summer hours results in a \$10.00 charge per hour payable to AAYHA before skater can be registered for the following year.

Exception: Any scheduled kitchen shift missed will be billed immediately **\$20.00** per hour and must be paid before skater can participate in any games. You are responsible for your scheduled kitchen shift unless you find someone to work your shift for you, and you notify the kitchen chairperson prior to the scheduled working time!

Option: Winter hour obligations may be bought out at time of sign-up, paid in full, for **\$375** per skater. You will still be responsible for your summer hours.

DUES PAYMENT OPTIONS:

Dues may be paid in full at sign-up night or in 3 equal payments. The first payment is due upon sign-up, second payment is due Nov. 1 and the 3rd payment is due Dec. 1. Only dues can be paid on this payment plan. Any outstanding AAYHA obligations due prior to sign-up must be paid in full in order to register. **If you choose the payment plan, please make all 3 checks out upon sign-up, dating check #2 for Nov. 1 and check #3 for Dec. 1.** Checks will not be cashed until the due dates.

PLEASE BRING ONLY CHECKS, NOT CASH FOR PAYMENT!! This will serve as your receipt, and speeds up the registration process!
